- 2. Parent must be a BPAA member in good standing
- 3. Have a current GPA of 3.0 or better, based on a 4.0 scale
- 4. Completed application
- 5. Include at least two letters of reference (by teacher, principal, employer, etc.)
- 6. Include an official or unofficial school transcript
- 7. Return all completed documentation and application to International Bowling Hall of Fame and Museum no later than March 31, 2020 (partial or incomplete applications will not be accepted)
