By signing this Urethane Inspection Form the player agrees to allow the USBC to conduct a field hardness test on the above specified equipment. In order to properly perform the field hardness test the player also agrees to allow the USBC to clean the above listed equipment with Isopropyl Alcohol and also allow a mill hole to be drilled above the finger holes to indicate the specific balls approval. Failure to allow USBC to conduct the field hardness test will deem the ball ineligible for use during this competition. For any ball that fails inspection, the ball shall be removed from competition and confiscated to prevent further use per the tournament rules.

USBC Urethane Bowling Ball Hardness Check at U.S. Open

Balls need to be dropped off at the urethane check-in table, located in Sun Valley Lanes, on Sunday, Feb. 16, between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m., or on Monday, Feb. 17, between 7 a.m. and 9 p.m. Balls will be tested using the ball hardness field test procedure, which requires the shell to be within a temperature range of 70 to 77 degrees Fahrenheit. You will be notified through email or text when the test is complete, so you may pick up your bowling balls.

This process can take several hours, dependent on the ball's temperature when received by USBC for inspection. Therefore, it is strongly encouraged to drop off all urethane balls during the allotted timeframe on Sunday, Feb. 16, to allow ample time for inspection to be completed. Urethane balls submitted for inspection on Monday, Feb. 17, during the allotted timeframe may not be immediately available for use in practice sessions until the balls have passed inspection.

Bowlers will fill out a urethane check-in card, which will be retained by USBC, when you drop off your equipment. All balls that pass the hardness field test will be returned with a mill hole (a permanent identification mark), signifying the balls passed the hardness test and can be used during the tournament. In addition, new urethane balls drilled on the PBA truck will come with an added mill hole as part of the drilling process.

Ball cards are to be turned in by 7:15 a.m. on Tuesday, Feb. 18. All urethane balls used in competition must have a mill hole. Any urethane ball thrown during the tournament that is not marked with a mill hole, to show it passed the hardness test, can result in the ball and bowler being disqualified and result in forfeiture of any prize money. The tournament director will make all final decisions.

Recently released urethane balls that require hardness testing are listed on the back side of this form; all urethane balls that are not listed, also require inspection.

Note: USBC is only requiring that bowlers check balls planned for use at the U.S. Open. However, USBC will be glad to test additional balls and welcomes bowlers to take this opportunity to confirm all urethane balls in your bag are legal.
