RULEBOOK

1. Format

- a. Qualifying rounds will consist of four traditional games.
 - i. Five players per team will complete traditional/singles games. Substitutions are allowed mid-game at any given frame. The player who started the game will receive credit for the final score. Once a player is substituted out, they may not re-enter play within that game.
- b. The top eight teams will advance to a double-elimination bracket. The last surviving team will be crowned champions.
- c. Matchplay rounds within the bracket will consist of three games, with total pins determining the winner.
- d. The format is subject to change and may be altered based on the number of teams participating.

2. Teams

Rosters will comprise a minimum of five players and a maximum of eight players. All teams must be official, BCAW/district-approved, unless otherwise approved by the tournament director. Girls may only bowl on boys' rosters if the school cannot send a girls' varsity team. Junior varsity entries will be accepted.

3. Singles Events

On Friday night, there will be a singles sweeper held at Dale's Weston Lanes. Players should contact Robert Vater by text to sign up at 920-815-1600. Players can check in starting at 5:30 PM, with bowling starting at 6:00 PM. The entry fee is \$40 for five games of qualifying, with players making the cut bowling an additional five games. Additionally, the individual games at Sunday's main team event will count towards All-Tournament Team awards.

4. Awards

The winning team in each division will earn a champion's plaque. The top five individual boys and girls will be named to the All-Tournament Team. Each All-Tournament Team member will receive a plaque and a Brunswick bowling ball.

5. Affiliation

This is not a USBC-sanctioned event, nor is it directly affiliated with the BCAW or HSBC.

6. Dress Code

Appropriate attire is required. An on-site tournament director will have discretion. Players must wear team jerseys and slacks. Girls may wear skirts/skorts, but they must be an appropriate length. All teammates must have matching jerseys.

7. Entry Fee

The entry fee will be \$125, which will cover lineage, media fees, awards, and other expenses. This is only about \$15 per bowler, given that there are eight on a roster, more than worth it for the experience.

8. Rules in Question

In the case that there are any questions or rule discrepancies, it will be left up to the tournament director's discretion. All tournament director decisions are final.
